And cheer in the grave acres' fruitful girth.

These young men are learning the traditions of the Ojibway's people. They are learning about their roles and responsibilities and how they apply to today's day and age. They come from different reserves in the area: Michipicoten, Garden River, Mississagi, and Wikwemikong.

They have travelled and sung all along the North Shore and have been requested to sing at various functions like conferences, graduations, and other gatherings.

These young men have been drumming together for a little over a year. They are being recognized for their dedication by Grammy-nominated drum groups as well as First Nations Elders and communities.
